The clay target shooting range has always been open to the public on club sanctioned days. The rifle / pistol range is open to club members only year round.

In the past our last clay target registered shoot for each year has been the first Sunday in October. We have also closed the club to Wednesday clay-target practice shooting at the end of October each year.

This year we have decided to stay open during the winter in order to give our shooters a place to shoot. We will not be throwing any registered targets during this time. Practice shooting and games will be the agenda.

We have chosen Saturday as the most likely day that a person may want to come out and participate.

If you are new to shooting or you have a young person you want to introduce to the shooting sports come on out. A club member will be happy to assist you on proper safety, gun handling, and shooting.

We will be open on Saturday's for practice from 10:00 am through 4:00 pm. Practice cost is \$4.00 per 25 birds.

Thomas E Sciscoe is the new caretaker and will be running and overseeing these Saturday shoots. As always Tom will be assisted by any of the club members that come out to shoot each Saturday.

This notice does not affect the rifle / pistol shooters on the range. The rifle / pistol range is open to members only on a year round basis. We have closed down trap three and trap four for the winter. We will be using only trap one and trap two. This should allow a safety margin for both clay target and rifle/pistol shooters to coexist on Saturday's during the winter.

Since the club house will be open the rest rooms will be available each Saturday. We have added an additional LP tank to supply heat to the club house during the winter so all shooters will have a place to warm up.

Whether you are a seasoned shooter, new to the trapshooting game, or a beginner we will try to have something for everyone.

Come on out for the fellowship – the coffee is always on. Come on out and give it a shot!
